3. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

PRO CARPET CLEANER is a cleaner and stain remover designed for carpets, rugs and upholstery.

Features

- ◆ Cleans domestic and animal stains
- ◆ Minimal soap residues
- ◆ Faint odor
- ◆ Low suds formula
- ◆ Use for manual or mechanical cleaning
- ◆ Low VOC
- ◆ Biodegradable – In conformity with OCDE 301 E rule
- ◆ For residential, commercial and institutional use

Packaging

Ready-to-Use Formula:

700 mL (23.6 oz) bottle; 118 mL (4 oz) refill bottle

Concentrate:

946 mL (32 oz) bottle; 4 L (1.05 US) gal bottle

Recommended Surfaces

- ◆ Natural and synthetic fibers carpet, rugs and upholstery
- ◆ Floor and furniture

Limitations

- ◆ Best performance at temperature between 15°C (60°F) and 30°C (86°F).
- ◆ Not designed to remove calcium and calcareous type stains. For this, use PRO NET II™.
- ◆ Generally not suitable for natural fiber and dyes.

5. INSTALLATION

Prevention Measures

PERSONAL SAFETY

- ◆ Wearing of gloves, safety glasses and appropriate clothing to prevent skin contact when using the product is always recommended.
- ◆ Please follow safety guidelines outlined in the "CAUTION" section indicated on the bottle (see hereunder).

NEIGHBORING AREA PROTECTION

- ◆ Always protect the neighboring working area against unexpected contact with the product to avoid irreversible damage or alterations that could only be restored by its replacement.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS

- ◆ Surface temperature should be between 15 and 30°C (60 and 85°F). Ideal temperature for best results.
- ◆ Test first on a small and adequate surface, to assess results.

First time user, without preliminary testing.

- ◆ Never use the product for the first time on a large area without preliminary testing.
- ◆ Even if the product is designed to clean safely textile fibers, it could irreversibly alter some fiber colors, in a way that they can only be corrected its replacement. Therefore testing on a small area is essential before use.

Methods of Application

Stain removal with Ready-to-Use formula:

- ◆ Using a spray gun bottle, spray directly the stain and let the cleaner work a few minutes while scrubbing gently to allow better penetration of the cleaner.
- ◆ Time required to remove stains varies with the type of stains and the type of fiber.
- ◆ When the stain is gone or greatly diminished, tap surface with a paper towel or a dry absorbing cloth.



Mechanical cleaning for large areas:

Routine Cleaning

- ◆ First, spray the cleaner on apparent stains.
- ◆ Dilute 1 part cleaner with 2 to 4 parts warm water in the soap container of the carpet cleaning extraction machine.
- ◆ Spread the cleaning solution on the carpet while agitating brushes. Let solution work 3 to 5 minutes and then pick-up.

Deep Cleaning

- ◆ Spray the cleaner undiluted all over the surface.
- ◆ Spray more generously on apparent stains.
- ◆ Let work a few minutes.
- ◆ Fill the soap container of the carpet cleaning extracting machine with water only.
- ◆ Spread the water on the carpet while agitating the brushes.
- ◆ Do not pick-up cleaning solution at the first passage.
- ◆ Allow the cleaning solution work 3 to 5 minutes and then remove.

Disposal

Do not dispose of excess cleaner into sewers; instead send to an appropriate recycling center.
