PRO 4175 has aggressive wet grab for even the stiffest flooring, provides early green strength (within 24 hours), and has superior long-term bond strength. PRO 4175 is solvent-free, formulated with antimicrobial protection to prevent the growth of mold, mildew and bacteria, and contributes to LEED® objectives and requirements. PRO 4175 is freeze/thaw stable down to -12°C (10°F).

Suitable Substrates

- Concrete
- Cement patching and leveling compounds
- Gypsum underlayment (ASTM F2429)
- Terrazzo
- Well-bonded vinyl composition tile (VCT) free of wax and with an embossing leveler such as PRO PATCH™ with PRO PATCH™ LIQUID
- Wood, such as APA grade plywood
- PRO BLOCK™ MMS or PRO BLOCK™ MMS ECO moisture management sealer system

Limitations

- For interior installations only.
- Do not use at temperature below 10°C (50°F) or above 35°C (95°F).
- Do not use where high moisture and hydrostatic conditions and/or recurring moisture problems exist.
- Do not install over concrete with a moisture vapor emission rate greater than 8 lbs per 1,000 square feet per 24 hours (per ASTM F1869), or when relative humidity conditions exceed 85% (per ASTM F2170), or a pH of 9.0 and higher.
- Do not install over substrates with dust, dirt, grease, curing compounds, adhesive residue including cutback, or any other deleterious material, which could reduce adhesion.
- Do not use to install vinyl-backed carpet or laminate.
- Do not install non-porous flooring over a non-porous substrate.
- Do not install over vinyl sheet goods.
- Do not store at extreme temperature (hot or cold) and protect from freezing under -12°C (10°F).

5. INSTALLATION

Surface Preparation

Inspect area to make sure all surfaces are sound, clean, dry, level and smooth. Plywood
minimum grade should meet CANPLY CSA-0121 or APA CC group 1. All cracks and
depressions should be properly filled with a PROMA high-quality cementitious
underlayment. Concrete surfaces should be free of excess moisture and have a proper
pH prior to installation (see Limitations).

Mixina

No mixing is required. This product is ready to use as is. Consult product SDS prior to use.

Application

- Select an appropriate trowel size according to the texture of the flooring material and floor surface.
- 2. Apply adhesive while maintaining a 45-60° angle with the floor.
- Lay in flooring material while adhesive is still wet to ensure 100% transfer of the adhesive. Periodically lift a corner to ensure full contact with carpet backing.
- Roll the flooring with the appropriate recommended weight roller across the width and length of the flooring surface.
- 5. Promptly clean any adhesive residue while still wet to make removal much easier.
- 6. Protect from light traffic for 12 hours and from commercial/heavy traffic for 24 hours.

Cleaning

Wet adhesive can be easily removed with warm soapy water and a clean rag. Use mineral spirits for dried adhesive. Caution should be taken with mineral spirits as it may be harmful to some material.
